SWAMI OMKARANANDA

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Sri Swami Omkarananda is an inspired poet, orator and Bala-Jneni. Swami Sivananada.

A young man enters a restaurant at 10 p.m., sips a cup of coffee over a period of more than an hour-even that is mechanical, for he is all-absorbed in a book which he devours through his eyes. A quiet corner in the restaurant is his safe retreat where he could have some time to study a few pages of Sri Swami Sivananda's "Spiritual Lessons" ! The hotel does not interest him: its noise does not disturb him either. He is lost in the Spiritual Lessons. He is oblivious of his surroundings. "He is conscious only that the eyes of his class-mates and relations are not prving suspiciously into his book, that no one is about who would rebuke this and say that he was wasting over an other-worldly-text precious time he could devote to his school-text. That young man is Hari Krishna, who even as a boy hailed the dawn of divine life.

In his autitude towards life, Sri Krishha was very different from his parents and forefathers. They were pious Grihasthas; the boy was an unyielding had come "back to his home." He felt as happy as would a Bhakta be if he suddenly found himself in Vaikuntha, Kailasa or Param-Dhama. Surcharged with the teachings of Sri Swamiji Maharaj he could not be at ease with himself till he fell prostrate at the feet of Sr Swamiji at Ananda Kutir; as though by a miracle, he at once regained his mental composure.

To understand Omkaranandaji's attitude towards Gurudev, one has to bear in mind that Jnaneswari was one of the first books that had the greatest attraction for him; the ideal of Guru-Bhakti that Saint Jnaneswar places before the Sadhaka, Swami Omkaranandaji adopted as his own. Anything even remotely connected with Gurudev is sacred to him: "to be grass under his feet, to be a door-mat in his kutir," to be in any position where he could be of any service to Gurudev, was to him the highest Sadhana. On arrival at the Ashram the "little boy-Sadhak" was promptly put to the dish-washing service, by the Ashram-authorities. When he was transferred to Sri Swamiji's Kutir on the same duty, Hari Krishna felt that he had actually attained the Supreme.

Sri Swamiji soon discovered the genius in Hari Krishna and with his characteristic tact, love and insight, took him into the office. Hari Krishna minded neither this nor that. To be at the feet of Gurudev and to serve him in any capacity was his sole aim and ambition. Wherever he worked, he wore himself out in service. When he was entrusted with preparing the press manuscripts of Sri



Swam iji's writings he converted night into day and worked not less then twenty hours a day.

Hari Krishna was initiated into the Holy Order of Sanyas on the 12th Sept. 1947. during the Sashti-purti celebrations of Sri Swami Sivanandaji Maharaj, with the Yoga-Patta, Swami Omkarananda Sarswati, and this only brought the Guru and his dynamic disciple closer together. Swami Omkaranandaji now became the righthand of Sri Swamiji Maharaj. When anything had to be done "in a minute", Swamiji would call "Omkar Swami." If some particularly heavy work had to be rushcd through, Omkarswamiji was always ready at hand. Omkaranandaji was one of the members of the Sivananda Yatra Mandali during Swami's all-India Tour, and rendered yeoman service to the divine cause.

What he is today is what he aspired to become, ten years ago—a first-class Sadhak to whom none exists in the world except the Guru, to whom there is no Dharma except Guru-Seva, to whom there is no scripture except Guru-Vakya, to whom there is no Moksha except to perpetually live in union at heart with the Guru.

THE SUN OF DIVINE LIFE

This sage Swami Sivananda appears to me, beyond doubt, to be the very embodiment and the clearest possible expression of the inherent but hidden spiritual consciousness of man in all its integrity, especially to these enmeshed in the veils of the delusion of temporal existence, to cast upon them the divine spell of spiritual awareness. at least in a limited measure, and to awaken them to their real exalted Essence in which one realises the Glorious Reality. To my knowledge,-and this is confirmed by the heaps of epistles received by this unique anchorite-he has been sowing spiritual seeds in the hearts of myriads of beings in every nook and corner of the world, even to the extent of being called indiscriminate as to whether the field is fertile or barren. The diary of my personal experience leads me to the conclusion that he has been and is teaching to innumerable individuals. fed on the bread of materialism, breathing the air of scepticism and groping in the darkness of delusion, that they are not born merely to die but to lead an eternal life, and live everlastingly in the Transcendent Divinity here. This divine personage has come to the rescue of numberless persons, caught in the quagmire of mundane

existence and purified them with the holy water of the love of the Lord Supreme. Today he is a mighty ship anchored in the spiritual harbour to take the individuals lost in their own ignorance across the sea of earthly life, to the Being of Consciousness-Bliss, from where there is no return. He is a Spiritual Magnet of love and wisdom attracting towards it with irresistible force every class of human personality; this they that have eyes to see will certainly behold. It may be that people of more penetrative intelligence, wider understanding and greater expanded consciousness will evaluate the entire picture of the Sage's life in a more catholic and impartial way. But the difference will be only one of the points of view of appraisement and will not extend to the essentials of the estimates.

This cosmic spiritual consciousness of his pulsates in the veins of one and all, since his inner being is identical with all. Every thought of his is charged with holiness, and is saturated with a sacred joy and a perennial peace and prevades the whole universe, rousing the spiritual institutes in man as they did in my case at the age of sixteen. These will continue to vibrate thus for aeons to come, and to transform the life of future generations. His blessings are inundating his admirers, in every pore of their beings. His material form which is but a symbol of his essential Form is enshrined in the temple of the heart of his devotees, both Eastern and Western. His pen is a sharp arrow that rends as under all the veils of illusion that screen the ultimate source of creation from the individual soul. His divinely inspired writings give a fatal blow to the ego-centric personalities of the phenomenal world as is evident from the experience of aspirants as intimated to the Divine Life Society. His works illuminate all paths of Yoga.

A short sojourn in the 'Abode of Delignt' of this glorious sage is sure to assuage the grief, revolutionise the mind and transform the lower nature of the individual self; and the visitor returns charged with a high spiritual force and a right sense of values. Even a mere superficial glance at the Swami is enough to bring home to you the Divine Presence in him; and the on-looker feels himself raised into a state of supreme joy. He i, a revealer of hidden Realities, besides which nothing is and nothing can be. He is the restorer of Purity, the essential nature of the Soul; the expresser of love, which is one of the aspects of Truth itself; the showerer of Grace, which is the hall-mark of all divinised persons; the awakener of man, which is the joyous work of all liberated sculs; and the infallible Guide of all. This is the manner in which my spiritual being has apprehended him, who is a portrait in minature, as it were, of the Plenum or the Bhuma.

Swami Sivananda is a perfect Advaitin, the Sankara of his age, before whose synthesising power the diversifying propensities of phenomenal nature seem to vanish like dew before the Sun. With my physical eyes I gaze at him, and, to my utter amazement and bewilderment, I seem to behold before me a beautiful and inspiring statue—a statue, not lifeless like a marble image but full of throbbing consciousness. There have been times, indeed, when I have been in a haze as to the nature of the embodiment of the Spirit: even as to whether it represents the paternal or the maternal force. Perhaps this is to be accounted for by the fact that it is the objective reflection of the Beauty of his inner self which transcends all ideas of sex. The very fibre of his body is made entirely of the stuff of spiritual-D slight.

He is an aposel of Philosophy, of Devotion, of Service and of all other ways of reaching the ultimate Destiny. Those whe have an earnest longing to have an idea of a living Sage, a living Christ, a living Janaka, a living Vyasa, a living Buddha, can appease their yearning by a personal observation of his ideal way of life. His love to Humanity at large is so over-flowing, indeed, that, as born-initiater, he pays but scant attention even to the scriptural injunctions as to the fitness of aspirants and tries to bring within the fold of his all embracing love every one who shows the slightest inclination to partake of his Life Divine.

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THE PROMETHEAN FIRE

The consummate wisdom of man is sageliness and the sages reflect the transcendent Divinity in Its essential They are those who have crucified their selves, nature. parified their natures and enshrined the Light of Divinity Absolute in their heart. In the lives of all saints and sages we see the universal Truth munifested. Their living is holy; their hearts are inexhaustible springs of Wisdom and Love: their words are godly; their presence is a spiritual healer; their beings are the embodiments of perfected Consciousness. They are the ocean of Power and Peace. They are the true representatives of the supreme Lord. Such a one is Swami Siyananda, the Blessed Peace of Bliss ! Much has been said of the Swamiji in many volumes and much is being said and will be said but only to express the inadequacy of language and the unfathomable nature of this unique spiritual personality whose ways are incomprehensible and workings 'inexorable'; true, it is, no mortal genius can explore the Kingdom of the Heart of saint or a sage.

Swami Sivananda has found the Eternal Truth and entering into the labyrinths of illusions and the consequent limitations, and so, he, like other prophets,



saints, sages and incarnations of every age and race, has begun to preach the living Gospel of his own life and experiences on the Godward Path of perfection and Beatitude! His writings,-sprung from his heart. which has an intimate knowledge of the Divine Existence and which experienced heart is the store-house of Knowledge,are simple and know no tricks; for Truth is simple. 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AUTHOR'S PREFACE

If man were Caesar alone, Plato would belie it; if he were Avistotle alone, Christ would disprove it. What is he, this arrogant soul that looks askance at Alexanders and Beethovens, Kants and Shakespears and finds no interest. worth or excellence in the unequalled geniuses of this good earth! The reason for this attitude of his, is apparently occult.

Deeply-rooted in the Power of Powers that animates all the universes, nurtured in the Nature's amphitheatre, man alone, of all creatures great and small, enshrines a deathless flame of yearning in his challenging bosom, to be infinite in all dimensions of his being; and so he disdains all partial geniuses cribbed. cabined and confined in regional development and in sordid weaknesses and limitations of mortal existence. Nothing is so marvellous, so mysterious as the soul of man that aspires to be at once ten Buddhas and Krishnas rolled in one, to be as perfect as its Father in Heaven and more.

The genius of life in every son of Adam, with its active energy is ever striving to rise above all limitations, crush and conquer all opposing forces, solve the riddles of the Sphinx of the inner Self, perv de through and through everything and assert its suzerainty over all earthly kingdoms and solar spheres. (When such irresisttible predisposition of the soul is monstrously perverted in men bereft of superior conscience and spiritual vision we have Hitlers and the like). It is in this innate dynamic tendency of life to unfold infinite gifts faculties and powers, to lengthen, deepen, broaden itself, to know and Be itself, that the supreme value of life lies.

How to stimulate and aid this deepest urge of the soul, unearth the rich treasures of the spirit, quicken the finer forces in the breast of man and bend them to the service of mankind is the problem and duty of philosophy and religion. Intellectual learning, and moral obedience are by themselves inadequate instruments to effect such a noble mission. So, not by mere Sceratic dialogue, nor by Zoroastrian philanthrophy, nor yet by Christian morality alone can we understand the splendour and glouy of inner Nature and move on earth like Christ and Shankara. illuminating, chastening and transforming the minds and hearts of men, distributing peace and joy, disseminating knowledge and wisdom. Brilliancy of intellect, moral life, scholarship, service and sacrifice need to be supplemented by spiritual vision, by surrender to the Hand of Heaven, by religious discipline and passionate love of God: only then will we be able to release the God-like Wisdom 'and the God-like Beauty buried in the inner recess of our heart.

Lack of full understanding of the inner constitution of men and inattention to the deeper parts of his being are

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the two fundamental defects whose noxious consequences are too manifest in our domestic, social, economic, political and international fields of life, to need any mention. No system of thought, no code of life that does not take into its consideration the inner-most depths of n an, will ever lend wings to mankind in its flight towards permanent peace, prosperity and happiness. This book, a collection of articles written a few years ago, is calculated to throw great emphasis on the spiritual values of life.

In so far as this book brings a bit of enlightenment to these of its readers who are completely in the dark about matter of spirituality, about life in God. in Truth, it will, I hope, herald th "Dawn of Divine Life" in their customary necks of living. And to those of its readers who are finiliar with the literature on Divine life, this will in a measure help them in their sacred and adventurous endeavours at making themselves the nest beautecus blessems of this wondrous creation, with the hue of erlightered nirds and with thearen a of divine life.

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THE LAST RESOURCE

There are strange moments in life when we are rudely awakened to the serious issues of the mundane existence, when our ratiocinative faculty is exercised to its utmost depths over these. It is in these moods of incisive discrimination or of intense mental searching that you come to see that life presents to you from moment to moment a series of difficult dilemmas and that it constantly places you in a net-work of monstrous perversions and a maze of bewildering fatualties. It is at such moments that seized by depair, you question yourself, 'who am I ?', 'what are all these seemingly solid phenomena around me ?' It is at such crucial moments that science and philosophy are found incapable of solving the subtle problems born from the deepest consciousness within yourself and that religion comes to your rescue by solving your problems, bracing your heart, promising you the Eternal Good and showing the way to it.

In such fateful crises of your destiny, religion alone gives you a new vision to find your way through the

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impasse of human rature, a new understanding to realise the nature, if not the non-existence, of your perploxing eniemas, a new heart with which to feel the consciousness of the absolute Truth, a new life to be lived in the Perfect Beauty of the universal Here and the everlasting Now. Without religion, life is an unaccountable shadow, an unmeaning dream, and a knotty riddle; with religion we are with unlimited rower and breathing Gods. moving perpetual peace. This is so, as religion enables us, as nothing else can, to see the ultim ate purpose behind all our activities, the spiritual meaning and the need of all the tragi-comedies of human existence. In other words, what has to be achieved is the perception of the vital harmony und rlying all apparent discord, the unity behind the seeming diversity, the One in all and all in the One.

Religion does not consist in mere going to the temples and the churches; not is it made up of unreasoning dogmas and ill-inderstood rituals. In one form or the other, it does not matter what, religion is the only saviour of mankind, religion that expands our heart and elevates our entire being. This alone can bring to mankind permanent peace and harmony and enable it to realise the fact that we are all children of the same Father; and the inspiration for this must flow from the spirit of the universality of all the religions and must, with its power and light, so transform the individuals that a recognition of the divinity that lies concealed in all men would follow automatically. Awake, therefore, O spiritual aspirants; do Sadhana. Let your lives exemplify the spiritual verities and demonstrate universal moral values. Through living a life of real religion, kindle the spark of spiritual consciousness throughout the world. The world today places its faith in you: it is in your hands to justify it by radiating peace and happiness to millions. Arise, then and do your part well.

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THE TRANSCENDENCE OF MAN

Man is a spiritual Being. God is the Substance with which he is made of. We live and move in His light. The highest Spiritual Consciousness is latent in all. It is the Law of the Lord that rounds the dew-drop; it is His Life that is pulsating in the timiest plant, in the meanest creature, in the smallest cell; it is His Power that enables the bud to blossom and the dry-leaf on the road to rustle. Lack of this knowledge of God is the root of all sorrows in life and misery in the world. The 'true happiness, the real ble-sciness of life consists in possessing the wisdom of God and governing our day-to-day activities in His Light.

The Self in man is the Lord, God. Nothing is wrong with man, though ignorance and darkness have penetrated into the very texture of his soul and life. He may be a fool, but he is a god playing at it; he may be wretched, but it may merely be a disguise of dividity; he may be a walking shrine of darkness; yet he has a lamp of deathless beauty ever-shining within him; he may be a denizen of a semi-hell in this world, but he has faint recollections of his citizenship in the heaven, in the Kingdom of God within him. Though reeling headlong in sensuality, he has a sense for the God-like.

The tragedy of all tragedies does not lie in whit man is, but in not knowing what he is and what he is essentially. His deepest folly and ruinous error is in not investigating himself. Essentially he is Truth; and Truth is neither an inference of logic, a metaphysical idea, not a moral principle nor an inscrutable mystery nor yet a problem for solution. Truth is the deepest consciousness in us, a reality to be experienced, a becoming, a Bring. As one Principle of Life man animates the entire existence, pulsates in every vein of every creature; as the Source of Light he makes the sun and the moon what they are; as unfathomable and all-pervading spirit he envelops the infinite skies. Spiritual Sadhana is a technique of extending one's life beyond the narrow limits of one's egoistic feelings and personal vanity, a process of growing into higher, loftier and diviner states of existence. A few sincere spiritual practices, a loving heart, a serving hand, a few minutes of meditation on the Lord within oneself, a clear mind, a determined will, patience and perseverence these are the royal methods to the attainment of Self-realisation.

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Spirit of Light, the Centre of Power and Wisdom. His plannings and schemings, fruitless speculations and cheri hed hopes in life, worldly ambitions and anticipations, have landed him in the kingdom of suffering. The self-centred life of limitations is the cause for all terror and forlornness, poverty and gloom, and all other woes.

Develop this "eye of intuition" through prayer and see the Majestic Lord sporting in every being and pulsating in every vein of the contents of the universe. [Sankirtan is food for the soul, nay, it is food for the mind and the body, too. Life can be sustained on Sankirtan: make your home a seat of Sankirtan, and it shall be a centre for the elevation of the mind, the transformation of the heart and a change in the vision of life.

The love for Sankirtan springs in a desireless heart. Therefore, empty your heart of all else and fill it with the melody of Sankirtan, for you shall, thereby, attain the Supreme Lord. While repeating the Name of the Lord, feel with all your heart that the Infinite God is seated in the temple of your heart and that He is within you. Also feel that the Lord is purifying your heart and that the Divine Grace is descending upon you.

Sankirtan breaks the knot of ignorance and makes the mind one-pointed. It is a great healer of the ills of life.

Be not worried and do not be anxious; you shall taste Infinite Joy and unceasing Peace. Destroy the thought of your own self by taking the Name of the Lord. Walk in the Way of God and move with Him. This is the Path of the Supreme Attainment, the casy path to God-consciousness.

Hold aloft the Banner of Sankirtan; thus shall you establish the Kingdom of God upon this earth. Even amidst the pressure of the most busy lives sing the name of the Lord, cultivate an unceasing awareness of the august Divine Presence, and remember the supreme Aim and Goal of life. Homan birth and the aspiratioon to live a divine life are spiritual opportunities which are rare privileges that are given to man by God, and should be utilised for the glorious purpose of attaining the Ideal for which they are given.

Blessed Children of God! Let the ego collapse. Let the lower nature be reduced to the dust and let your being be filled with the Consciousness of God. All passes away. Nothing remains. That which is Real and Permanent is God or Truth alone. All is vanity on this earth. Plunge deep into the ocean of Sankirtan. Shut all the doors and windows and rest in the Inner Peace. Unite your soul with the Lord and draw from Him whatever you need, for He is the Storehouse of all that there is.

THE LIGHT THAT LIGHTETH 1 EVERYWHERE

There is One Supreme Light which ever burns steadily and surely, and that Light Eternal is God who lighteth every soul and all that is. 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THE NEED FOR SELF-SCULPTURE

Culture is a supreme art of life, the technique of self-sculpture, a way of tiding over the defects that eat the very vitals of our life, if not the beauty of our soul, a scientific living of discipline and growth: it is an integration of beir.g, a steady evolution into our real Self; into Godhead itself; only, it enables us to do all this even while in the busy

world of work and strife, and not necessarily in the imaginary safety of the solitude of mountain caves.

Science, of which great expectations were entertained in the initial stages of its growth and development, has not come to our rescue: on the other hand, it is acting as an adverse force that wrests and distorts our innace urge for final perfection and heading us towards a wreek. We must admit that, in spite of its glorified achievements and of the much boasted progress in our civilization and culture, we are crude and coarse in reality, that we lack the radiant gladness and fullness of life, that we are steadily drifting away from the essentials, and, hence, from the universal, which is the sap of life and the essence of all-existence.

The basic reason for all the fissures in life lies in our failure to base our lives on religious cuiture, which gives us a proper sense of spiritual and, therefore, of fundamental values, and supplies us with a vision by which to live a full life of freedom and happiness in the vastness of the Spirit, a true life in the very heart of the universe.

We are passing through critical moments in the history of human life: the magnitude of our misery is steadily on the increase. As long as we do not aim at an internal transformation through a weeding out of the undesirable elements and effect invidual regeneration through a steady development of the innate goodness latent in every heart, we cannot hope to escape the

impending dangers, the threatening perils, arising out of our ignorance.

The highest spiritual consciousness, which is the heritage of every man, abhors all isolation of his existence, assailed, as it is, by all manners of absurdities in this imperfect world. It is culture, self-sculpture, alone that can soothe and satisfy the spirit in him by helping him to dissolve his selfish interests, to transmute his ruinous passions, to conquer fear and death, to chisel his coarse personality into the typical image of the selfeffulgent Beauty of the Supreme which is God, and give him the light of truth to live an inner life, the perfect life of transcendent majesty.

ART-THE EXPRESSION OF DIVINITY

All beings however low in evolution, all actions however trivial in their nature, all things however lifeless they may appear to be, bear the stamp of the Light of the Eternal; the Principle of the Beautiful is dancing in them all; the Splendour of the Truth is shining equally in all creation—in the man toiling in the field, in the birds and the beasts of the forest, in the blossoms of the garden, in the waves of the sea There is only One Law of Life that is pulsating in the veins of the contents of the entire universe. Glory to the Divine Being.

Every speck of space is rich with the inexhaustible abundance of Goodness, of Godliness, of Beauty. One has to widen one's consciousness and deepen one's spirit to be able to develop the vision of all spirit shining in and through matter, all reality revealing itself in and through the unreal. To escape from this world of limitations while yet being on earth, into the boundless world of Freedom and Beauty, Power and Brilliance, is the purpose of our existence.

For the one who has eyes to see, all is Goodness, all is Sweetness; everything is Beautiful, everything is Graceful; whatever he perceives is homogeneous and harmonicus. Children of Light!. Behold the brilliance of the diamond in the darkest coal mine; lock at the lustre of the eyes in the uglicst face: smell the fragrance of the Lotus in the stinking pond; feel the Omnipresence of your life in the lowliest creature revelling in filth; discover the greatness of the genius in the humblest family grovelling in poverty. To one with insight whatever is met with will be seen to be the master-touch of the Divine Painter, of the master-Artist, who expresses himself in such infinite and ineffable Beauty.

Art is not for the fleeting pleasures of the human creature nor a solace to the sorrow-stricken heart nor yet for mere aesthetic enjoyment; it is more than all these—it is a systematic and scientific living in absolute beauty, in infinite harmony, in perfect peace, in eternal Joy. Art is a kingdom of intense feeling, a feeling in which one is aware of the One Undivided Divine Essence of Existence. Art is majestic and mystic, idealistic and symbolic, supernatural and transcendental, an expression of the unseen in and through the seen.

That art blossoms into Perfection, which is free from all sense desires and physical interest. In the name of art one should not fetter oneself in the prison of professionalism and sensualism. The artist should be moved by the Beauty of Truth: and his art should be progressively creative and spiritually suggestive: it should be a revelation of his moments of inspired vision and of total selfsurrender. In his creative moods the artist should zoar high—high into the skies of humin us Imagination and of glorious Existence, wholly oblivious of all mundane madness. Purified in heart, one should wave the magic wand of art at whose touch everything is converted into the Beauty of the Beyond.

Let the drawing rooms be filled with the vibrations of the highest spiritual ideals which pour into us the power and beauty of a new life of joy and peace. Let the wielder of the brush be free from all stoff of pride and selfishness and from all that is related to the sense world, so that the Divine may fill him with His Will to paint the pictures that breathe healing power and soothing balm into all onlookers through their eyes, so that they may be relieved of their illness of mind and sickness of heart. Let your art be a lamp of deathless beauty, shining with an effulgence dispelling the darkness of the soul that sings the sorrowful songs of the world.

An art that panders to the lower appetites of men, that does not aim at discovering the meaning of life, that does not awaken the spiritual consciousness in the human heart, is soulless and, therefore, unsalutary in its effects and malefic in its influence. The test of true art is implied in its profoundest suggestions. True art should embody the best genius of the artist, the finest in him, and awe one into a subtler plane of refinement and thrill; all art that falls short of this great purpose is profane and perishable.

REAL WISDOM

Man's nescience has wrought havoc; blasts of adversity and blows of fate seem to be his lot; tons of loads appear to be pressed upon his weak shoulders, and he sits forlorn and crying. The ignorant man's pangs of greed for glittering gold, for fleeting fortunes, has hidden from his sight the infinite treasures garnered in his own heart. An impassioned fostering of ignorance has made living a series of tormenting tragedies, mounting melancholies and hollow hallucinations.

A positive and emphatic affirmation of the earthly kingdom has negated the Kingdom of God in the vast expanse of one's own heart. Lack of sincerity on the individual's part has made deliverance from despondency well nigh impossible. Utter absence of love for the Divine has closed the portals of Perfection and the fullness of joy. Life's manifold mourning that clouds the heart and the bitter sobs that shake the frame make one feel that life spells discord, disintegration, disease and death. instead of his being deluged by the bliss of the thought that life springs from the Delight of Divinity, from Awareness, Unity and Immortality.

O Man! discern the objective of your existence on eart^h, which is a spiritual awakening, a gradual yet grand process of the unfolding of the Consciousness of the Divine, which you are essentially. Through wisdom, master the secrets of all sciences, know the exact nature of things, tune your self to the workings of the Divine Nature of of the Laws of Truth. Wisdom is the key to the Plenitude of Power and Joy. It saves one from countless sufferings and innumerable sins, cuts at the root of ignorance and confers upon you Peaceful harmony and Absolute perfection.

Man is whirled round and round in the storm of life when he clings to his ego, his lower self, his limited life. The sorrow of phenomenal life is rooted in the idea of individual living; a living of isolation and suffering, which is fed by the delusion of separative independence and permanent multiplicity of beings. To escape from such a self-made net-work of tormentations, wisdom is the only means, as that alone will lead you to a realisation of the real oneness of Being.

Wisdom is acquired through right thinking, philosophical reflection, negation of creative imagination in relation to phenomena, attainment of equanimity in pairs of opposities like pleasure and pain and direct experience of spiritual verities.

To know that whatever is found to exist forms merely part of the One Homogeneous Unity of Pure Consciousness is wisdom: it is the result of the realisation of the Divine Oneness of living around us. To be aware of the One Reality--call it whatever you like-with intensity of

TRUTH AND ITS REALIZATION

Truth is the eterual Brahman. Truth is Silence. Truth cannot be expressed. Expression is change. Everything that changes itself is untruth. Besides Truth there is not and cannot be, anything. Truth is existing as one with All. Truth is identification with the immortal Essence. Truth is undecaying. From It all things proceed. In it all things exist. Into It all things re-enter. Truth is the Imperishable Home of all beings. Truth is the ocean of unalloyed Bliss, a small fraction of which sustains the entire universe. Truth is Life and Existence. Untruth is decay and death. Universal love is Truth. Barriers between one thing and another are untruth. The Real is the Truth of truths. That is what Exists, Triumphs and Rules.

All, right from Brahma down to the blade of grass, are seekers of the One Truth, some consciously, some unconsciously, differing only in degrees of consciousness, the extent of mental purification of subtlety of condition. Every act of life here is a step taken nearer the Truth, for Truth is the Joyous Abode of all beings. Into It all enter¹ and find complete Satisfaction and Supreme Peace.

The Preliminary requisites of a secker after the Truth are embodied in the Sadhana Chatushtava which comprises discrimination, dispassion, tranquillity, selfrestraint, cessation from earthly business, power off endurance, faith in Truth, concentration of mind and yearning for liberation. A mastery over these qualities is succeeded by practical meditation. This is done either through service and self-sacrifica-(Karma Yoga), devotion and self-surrender (Bhakti Yoga) or discrimination and knowledge (Jnana Yoga). These three roads lead to the common ideal and Goal of all, the all-embracing Unity; call It God, the Truth, the Absolute, or whatever you will. Words do not matter. It is feeling that counts; and that is the same.

Robed in the sagely garment of perfect tranquillity, of contentment, of calmness of mind, of the power of endurance, of unflinching faith in the Self, the inner Berry of all, of right knowledge of scriptures and profound meditation, ye shall march to the Supreme Seat of Eternal Glory and Truth-Realisation.

Blessed are they, the Truth-seckers, who have emptied their heart and rooted out their ego, the sense of separateness, the force of nescience, and have shattered the self-made limitations and boundaries for, thereby, they shall be filled with the Bliss o: Truth !

A merciless withdrawal from the sense of separateness and an affirmation of the idea of Unity constitute the central point of all Sadhana (spiritual practices)

in all religions. One who feels that he is one thing and the other is another has turned away from Truth and has opened the gates of self-imprisonment. Love all. Be one with all! See the One in all! Make no distinction. Off with all meaningless differences. Enough of barriers between man and man, between one thing and another. You are all the waves of the One Ocean of everlasting Life. Hence, you all are One — only one! Remember this. Practise this! Realise this.

THE WAY TO LIFE EVERLASTING

This bewildered and tumultuous world, with its never-ending tale of toil and tears is in reality a majestic University of Wisdom wherein everyone gets a chance to learn from the living Book of Life, of their own as well as those of philosophers of realization, of saints and sages, of divine teachers and holy masters. They that hug their ego, however, will learn nothing in this Grand University, and all that they have shall be taken away, leaving them forlorn. The man of ego loves his own ignorance : he glories in his own foolishness and attaches great importance to his perishable body. Thereby he exposes himself to the winds jof adversity, the storms of wees and strokes of fate and afflicten in short he is filled with nescience and, in his audacity. disobeys the Law of Life. Such a man shall have no admission into the portals of eternal Good and supreme felicity: He will be imprisoned in his own cocoon of misery and shall never be let out into the boundless Empyrean of Blessedness.

Looking through the warped perspective of his own ego, man makes this earth a Hell of gloom and death, tortures and frustrations. By looking through the medium of his own illusions and a sensuous mind, he converts what could be a temple of happiness (this world) into a den of anguish and grief, terror and forlornness. Laws of darkness and death rule him, and not those of Light and Life. Staying in his own ego, man invites invasion by sin and ultimate annihilation.

Wisdom appears to him as folly. Purity as impurity, Perfection as imperfection, Humility as cowardice, Meckness as weakness, Service as attachment and passion, Compassion as hypocracy: everything appears to be just its opposite to the man's perverted mind, intoxicated with the wine of ego.

The man of ego is ruled by vanity; he is governed by utter pride; hatred grips him, folly sways him, delusion sits in his very intelligence, evils hover round him and his steps lead him into the realms of denser ignorance and ruin. But, his understanding being clouded and his discrimination obscured by his own prejudiced preconceptions, he is unaware of his own sorry state ! On the contrary he feels himself well off and all-knowing and looks upon the rest of humanity with a condescending eye as unfertunate creatures teiling feelishly far below him in the scale of evolution! Such is the selfdelusion the ego produces !

Where this egoism is not present, it is all blessedness, all goodness, all glory; and there one can find God. One who has no egoism has all wisdom.

To the one devoid of ego, the whole world is a haven of rest, a realm of peace and a kingdom abounding in

all-happiness. For him there is no more distress: he is purified, exalted and illumined; he sees no sin anywhere, and no evil can come near him. Nothing is hidden from him; the Truth stands before him in all its Splendour and Radiance, all the mysteries of the universe are revealed to him and all the secret workings of Nature are an open book. He who has no ego and who has surrendered himself to God is the master of every power and force that there is: fcr, all powers and forces are under God, the Lord. The egoless man quickly attains Supreme Freedom and Perfection.

Very difficult indeed, is it to sacrifice the ego; but unless it is done, no Vision of Truth and no Sight of God can be had. Sell away your lower self and purchase the Supreme Self. Withdraw your mind from justifying your position: serve your enemies; love those who hate you; resist not if you wish to conquer; sacrifice all your rights if you wish to rule; seek nothing if you wish to have everything; conquer yoursef if you wish to have the Highest Freedom; take no shelter under the ego if you wish to be protected by the Supreme Power, the Almighty God.

Let one get beyond all forms of the ego, and one shall see the Divine Truth reflected in one's own heart within, shall be illumined forthwith by the Divine Knowledge. Let the ego be destroyed; lose your self in the love of all; negate your self by merging it in the service of all, and thereby, you shall see that you have become one with the Supreme Lord, who is all this vast universe.

Empty yourself of your egoism and all the impurities connected with it, and you shall see the Inexhaustible Abundance of God filling you to the brim, nay, filling you so much that you cannot contain it any longer. Sacrifice a little of your ego, be it ever so little, a fraction of it shall be deemed sufficient pretext for God to inundate your being with His Grace, His Power and His Light. Such is His Divine Love and Compassion.

Practise a little self-denial and cultivate indifference towards the turmoil of outward happenings, towards the external surge of likes and dislikes, and the seemingly crushing stress of life, and fall back upon the Lord: this will enable you to enter the kingdom of everlasting peace, immeasureble wisdom and eternal joy !

MAHAVAKYAS OF RELIGIONS

Life is something grand and majestic, full of meaning and purpose. It has a profound philosophy and a grand goal. It is an immortal dance of beauty on the stage of eternal truth and goodness. It is a self-luminous luminosity, a self-sufficient entity. It is wisdom to know and speak of life as a realm of reality and a centre of joy in itself. This truth of life cannot be proved by the help of our senses or by anything in the phenomenal world, but can only be experienced in the deepest recess of one's own heart of awareness.

The very nature of the individual life is to expland itself into the unlimited castness of the Infinite, to be seated in the heart of all, to govern the life of all, to rule the universe from within, to wield perfect power and blivs.

The purpose of our life here is to dance to the rhythm of the beat of the Eternal Heart of the Supreme Beloved, to become identical with the Light of Truth and thus live the fullest life, the divine life, a life in God, breathing, eternal youth and unfading freshness, moving in limitless wisdom and peace.

Every phase of tife has in it some poetry; every facet of life glows with the Eternal light of Truth; every storm and stress of life is rich with the splendour of spiritual glory. The whole world is throbbing with the consciousness of God who is the source and end of all that is. Man's duty consists in being in harmony with this all-pervading principle of God.

This innermost immanent principle within all existence, the highest spiritual consciousness that is latent in all, is' a pure unity without parts, a unique homogeneity admitting of no differences. To guide and help us to experience this One Undivided Essence, the immortal masters of all religions have handed down to us beaconlights of Mahavakyas or great utterances embodying their innermost experience, which contain in themselves the quintessence of all the spiritual wisdom necessary for the world. A few are given for comparison and meditation.

CHRISTIANITY :	"I and my Father are one."
CONFUCIANISM :	The three secrets of happiness are to see no $evil$, to bear no evil, and to do no evil.
HINDUISM:	Tat Twam Asi - 'That thou art'.
JAINISM:	Ahimsa Paramo Dharma. — Non-injury is the highest religion.
JUDAISM:	Be still and know that I am God.
ZOROASTRIANISM:	He is but the same one God, but men give him diverse names. Hoomta, Hookta, Havareshta, Manshi, Gavasni, Kunasni: pure thought, pure words, pure deeds.

MOHAMADANISM:		La Illahi Illullah — Mahomed Rasullullah. There is no God but Allah and Mahomad is the Messenger of Allah.
SIKHISM:		Ek Omkar, Satnam: There is but one God. His Name is Truth.

These Mahavakyas summarise and reveal the central truth in all religions, the essence of all paths to perfection, the goal of all wisdom and spiritual practices, of the oneness of life and self and or the nature of Truth, which is free from all change, impersonal and all-pervading.

These Mahavakyas of great sentences are the master key to the manifestation of the perfection of the soul, the unveiling of the Essential Nature of the Self. A continuous repetition of any one of these Mahavakyas awakens the inherent spiritual consciousness within us. Profound meditation on these Mahavakyas generates a tremendous force in life which results in the realisation of Truth or the Absolute.

RAYS OF WISDOM

What Is Life?

1. Life is a journey from impurity to purity, from hatred to cosmic love, from death to immortality, from imperfection to perfection, from slavery to freedom, from diversity to unity, from ignorance to eternal wisdom, from pain to eternal bliss, from weakness to infinite strength.

2. Life is a great opportunity provided by the Lord for His children to evolve into Himself. Understand the purpose of the Almighty in every station of your life.

3. It is upto us to make the best use of this instrument, to keep it sharp and useful for the divine purpose. Union with the Lord is obtained here when at every place we discern Him and Him alone as pervading every atom of existence, when we develop divine virtues to perfection and when we do His will, after a complete conquest of the lower nature. This is achieved by leading the Divine Life of Truth, Love and Purity.

Mysteries of Mind

4. Practice of telepathy, thought-reading, hypnotism, mesmerism and psychic healing clearly prove that the mind exists and that a higher developed mind can influence and subjugate the lower mind.

5. Through the play of the mind in objects, proximity appears to be a great distance and vice-versa. The mind has the potency of creating or undoing the whole world in the twinkling of an eye.

6. Friend and enemy, virtue and vice are in the mind only. Every man creates a world of good and evil, pleasure and pain, out of his own imagination only.

7. The things that we perceive all around us are only mind in form or substance. "Manomatra Jagat." Mind creates; mind destroys. Bitterness and sweetness do not lie in the leaves, but they are in the subject. They are created by the mind.

8. It is the mind that gives colour, shape, qualities to the objects. Mind assumes the shape of any object it intensely thinks upon.

The Sub-Conscious Life

9. Beneath your conscious life there is a very wide region of sub-conscious life.

10. Subconscious life is more powerful than your ordinary life of objective consciousness. Through the practice of Yoga you can modify, control and influence the sub-conscious depths.

11. All habits originate from the sub-conscious plane. The superconscious experience is Turiya or the fourth state. It is Nirvikalpa Samadhi or the state of perfect awareness of one's real Swaroopa of oneness with the Supreme Being.

Right And Wrong

12. All are confused on the terms right and wrong. Even the most learned men are puzzled in finding out what is right and what is wrong. Even the sages and seers find it difficult to define these terms precisely.

13. That which elevates you and takes you nearer to God is right, that which brings you down and takes you away from God is wrong. To work in accordance with the Divine will is right.

14. That work which gives elevation, joy and peace of mind is right, that which brings depression, pain, restlessness is wrong. To give pleasure to others is right, to spread misery and pain to others is wrong.

Positive Overcomes Negative

15. Positive always overcomes the negative. This is the law of nature.

16. Negative evil thoughts cannot stand before positive good thoughts. Courage overcomes fear. Patience overcomes anger and irritability. Love overcomes hatred. Purity overcomes lust.

Do You Want God ?

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17. Do you really want God? Do you really thirst for His darshan? Have you got real spiritual hunger? God is a question of supply and demand. If there is demand for God, the supply will come at once. 18. Pray faithfully like Prahlad. Sing like Radha. Repeat His name like Valmiki, Tukaram and Tulsidas. Do kirtan like Gowranga, weep in solitude like Mira over the separation from the Lord. You will have darshan of the Lord this very second.

Path Of Pleasure

19. Sensuality destroys life, lustre, strength, vitality, memory, wealth, fame, holiness and devotion to the Supreme. It drags a man down to the abyss of hell.

20. Sensual pleasure is like honey that is mixed with virulent poison. One anna of sensual pleasure is mixed with fifteen annas of pain.

2: Sensual enjoyment is attended with various defects, sins, pains, attachments, bad habits and mental restlessness.

22. Man is generally attracted by brilliant light, beauty, intelligence, varied colours and pleasant sounds. Do not be deceived with these paltry things. Enquire within. What is the substratum for all things? There is one Essence at the back of the mind and all objects of this seeming sense-universe. That essence is all-full and self-contained. That essence is Brahman of the Upanishads. You are that Essence. Tat Twam Asi.

Nothing Like These !

23. There is no fire like last, no evil like anger, no vice like hatred and no sword like abase.

24. Passion makes one beggar of beggars and blind. The organ of sight does great mischief. Destroy the lustful look, the adultery of the eye. Take to the path of divine evolution and try to see God in all.

25. Selfishness is the source of all vices. A selfish man injures others, robs their property and does many sinful actions to satisfy his selfishness.

26. Selfishness constricts the heart. A selfish man has neither scruples nor character. Peace of mind is unknown to him. It is selfishness that prompts a man to do evil acts.

27. From anger arises delusion, therefrom confusion of memory, from confusion of memory loss of reason; reason]gone, the man is destroyed.

Index To Character

28. Character is what you are, reputation is what people think you are. The best treasure of man is a noble character.

29. Forgiveness is the ornament of the sage. Anger is the passion of fools.

30. Mercy is the might of the rightcous. Viveka is the weapon of the aspirant. Vairagya is the armour of Mumukshus.

31. A timid man or coward dies many times before he actually dies. A sage does not find any difference between a male and a female and a piece of wood; he sees the inner Essence in all.

32. The proud and the covetous are always restless. The first test of a truly great man is his humility, simplicity, love and mercy. 33. Purity is the best jewel of a Yogi. It is the greatest treasure of a sage. It is the best wealth of a devotee.

Conscience

34. Conscience is a form of truth. It is the knowledge of our own acts and feelings as right or wrong. It is a sensitive balance to weigh actions. It is a guiding voice from within.

35. Sense of duty is conscience. Scrupulousness is conscience. Conscience is like a silent witness and a silent. teacher. It is the light of the soul that is burning within the chambers of your heart. Conscience grows through experience.

36. When you do a wrong action, the conscience pricks you. You experience pinpricks. It says to you in a clear, small, shrill voice: "Do not do this wrong action, my friend. It will bring misery to you." A conscientious man at once ceases to act wrongly any further and becomes wise.

37. In a wicked man, this faculty becomes dead. The sensitive nature of conscience is destroyed by sin or corruption; hence, he is not able to discriminate right from wrong.

The Culture Of The Heart

38. Your heart is harder than flint or steel as it has been the repository for evil qualities such as greed, mixerliness, harshness, rudeness, anger, pride. It is your foremost duty to soften it.

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39. You have made your heart crooked and narrow through hypocrisy, untruthfulness, backbiting, etc. It is your onerous duty to expand it now.

40. You must purify your heart now. Only by the practice of the Samanya Dharma, by the development of the virtues can you soften your heart, expand it and purify it.

41. Have a large heart. Be liberal in your views. Expand. Include all. Break all barriers.

42. The inner motives of a man form the seed and root of all his life's activities.

43. Purify your motives and possess a pure heart. You can move the whole world by your spiritual force.

44. The more you spend your energy in elevating and serving others, the more energy will flow to you. The noble soul who always does good to the world entertains sublime divine thoughts is a blessing to the world at large.

Power Of Thought

45. Thought is both force and motion. Thought is dynamic, thought moves.

46. Thoughts can shape a man. Think that you are Brahman and become Brahman

47. Your character depends upon the quality of thought held in your mind and the mental pictures and ideals entertained by you. Avoid useless and base thinking.

48. Trial is a crucible into which nature throws a man whenever she wants to mould him into a sublime superman.

49. Without sorrows, without persecution, none can become a saint or a sage. Every suffering is meant for one's upflit and development.

50. Uncongenial atmosphere, unfavourable environments and obstacles will help one only in carrying on the struggle more vigorously.

51. A real hero rejoices in suffering. He willingly undergoes pain and suffering in order to serve and please others as well as to mould himself in the proper way.

52. Trial and tribulation in the form of physical suffering or mental grief are sent by the all-merciful Lord for your own ultimate good.

53. Sufferings purify the Soul. They burn the gross material sins and impurities.

54. The Divinity becomes more and more manifest. They give inner spiritual strength and develop will force, the power of endurance.

55. Religion is the manifestation of Divinity already in man. Life without religion is real death.

56. Religion is the attainment of the Divine Consciousness or divine Wisdom.

57. Religion is freedom from ignorance, illusion, fear, doubt, grief and delusion.

58. Prayer is a mighty spiritual force. It is the real force of gravity or attraction.

59. Prayer elevates the mind; it can reach a realm where reason dares not enter—the Kingdom of God.

60. Prayer generates good spiritual currents and produces tranquillity of the mind. If your pray regularly, your life will be gradually changed and moulded.

61. The only support in this Kali Yuga is the name of God. Name of the Lord gives immense bliss and removes all great sins.

62. The grains that eling to the pivot are safe in a grinding mill. Even so, those who eling to the Lotus Feet of the Lord and His name are not affected by the miseries of Samsara.

63. The Lord is within you and all arround you. Open your eyes and behold him everywhere.

64. God pervades the entire universe. He walks in in the garb of a beggar. He moans in pain in the guise of the sick. He wanders in the forest clad in rags. Open your eyes. See Him in all. Serve all. Love all.

65. The relief obtained by remembrance of God in adversity indicates that there is a hidden Power guiding all.

66. Everything is God. Good is God ; misfortune is God. Greet Him in everything and rest peacefully in Bliss ! May, God bless you !

67. Love is the greatest power of all powers. Love is a Divine Power. Love unites, redeems and saves.

68. Love flows spontaneously from a pure heart like the Ganges. It always gives and never takes anything.

69. There is no virtue higher than love, there is no treasure higher than love, there is no religion higher than love. Love is Truth and love is God Him self.

70. Wherever there is love there is peace and wherever there is peace, there is love.

71. Lead the divine life. Help the cause of the divine life. If you co-operate and help to further the divinc life, you are indeed laying a brick in building up once again the glorious monument of Bharatian culture. our heritage of universal peace and well-being.

72. By furthering the Divine Life cause, you actually promote world peace and brotherhood and prosperity.

73. Divine Life is not possible without self-control and self-perification. Self-control augments energy, vitality, vigour and mental strength. Divine life is the simplest thing, the most natural life that every man should lead. But artificial conditions created by advancing materialism — Kali—has blurred the vision of man who is led astray in spite of himself.

74. For a man of contentment, sovereignty of the whole world is no better than a bit of rotten straw. He is indeed miscrable and poor, who is discontented.

75. Never complain against the bad environments. Create your own mental world wherever you remain, you go and be contented with whatever Lord gives you.

76. He who develops a balanced mind and equal vision is always contented.

77. To know the Truth that underlies all manifestations is wisdom. It is Brahmasakshatkara or Self-realization: you will find yourself the beauty of beauties.

78. Wisdom is the sharpest weapon. It surely saves you from all evil and ills.

The da-kest hour precedes the dawn. When there is intense pain, know relief is at hand. God is your Antaryamin or Inner Ruler. He knows everything. He is merciful. Past karmas have to be worked out.

79. People praise you now and censure you the next moment. There never was, there never will be, nor is there now a man who is always censured or a man who is always praised. Therefore, be above praise or censure, honour and dishonour. Through discrimination and meditation rest in the Nirdwandwa state.

80. There is nothing that is beyond the pale of man's achievements in the universe because, in reality, he is all this. Only an inner determination to tear off the veil and to perceive the unity of Existence is needed.

S1. Mental peace is obtained only by complete Selfsurrender to the Lord who is our Father, Friend, Philosopher and Guide! In times of stress His Will comes unfailingly to our aid

S2. Peace can be achieved only by removing the weeds of lust, greed, malice and selfishness. When the thirst for sensual objects dies, only then man enjoys peace.

Silence

83. Silence develops will-power, checks the force of Sankalpas and gives peace of mind.

84. The language of silence is more forcible than the language of speech. Observance of silence or Mowna daily for 2 hours is very necessary to conserve the lost energy that is wasted in useless controversies and debates and idle gossips.

Today's Sinner Is Tomorrow's Saint

85. A sinner is a saint of tomorrow. Even dacoits have become great Rishis or sages. Therefore exert, purify, approach the saints. Abandon all anxiety, fear and worry. Rest in your centre. Sing OM. Meditate on OM. Realise the Self.

86. Sharpen the intellect. Thin out the ego. Let the Light Divine shine in you in all Its splendour through leading constantly the Divine Life. Prostrate before all. This will enlighten your life. Cultivate the spirit of love and humility, compassion, and tenderness which filled the heart of the Lord Buddha and Lord Jesus.

Illusion Or Maya

87. Illusion is born of ignorance. From illusion springs separation, difference, duality, manifoldness and variety. Therefore destroy the ignorance by the sword of knowledge of the Self and become free.

88. What a strange world! How powerful is Maya! In an instant she strangles the reason in man, and drags him into the very bottom of the pit of ignorance, immorality and adharma. Pray to the Lord that He may endow you with clear understanding and devout heart.

89. Maya havoes through the mind. If you under, stand the nature of Maya fully well, you will not be affected by her.

Guiding Light

90. Ill-health is a myth. It does not exist beyond the range of the physical and mental sheaths. The body and mind alone are subject to diseases. The Atman, your true Self is beyond these and therefore eternally free from diseases and death. During illness, detach yourself from the body. Connect the mind with the Buddhi and soul. "As you think, so do you become!" Therefore, assert you are healthy. Disease will take to its heals.

91. Grief is the effect of delusion. The true Inner Self of man is immortal; it can never die. In accordance with the prarabdha the Jiva takes on a body and discards it. Death does not mean destruction. Will a woman sit and cry if her husband discarded old clothes and put on new ones ?

92. Fear? That is the lot of sinners and ignorant people. What has fear to do with one who has resolved to lead the life divine?

93. Fear is what lazy people talk of. Those who exert can do miracles. Have immense faith in Him.

94. Love of flesh is a nuisance, love for the soul is devotion. Devotion is the essential condition of Brahma vidya. It is the sweetness of life. It softens the heart and removes jealousy, hatred, lust, anger, egoism, pride, arrogance.

95. When one develops all-embracing and all-inclusive love, the petty life of hurry, worry, excitement and competition seems to him as nothing, when compared with the everlasting life of eternal sunshine and bliss in the soul within.

96. The greatest possession is devotion to the Lord. When you have this, everything else is easy of acquisition. Material comforts will come to you at His bidding.

97. The scientific attempts to probe the Infinite are futile. The only scientific method here is the intuitional.

98. He whose mind is calm, who is endowed with the four means of salvation, who is free from defects and impurities can realise the Self intuitively through meditation.

99. It is easy to develop intellect, but how very difficult is it to develop Vairagya and ethical perfection.

100. There is an inherent innate desire in all human beings for freedom, independence and eternal happiness. Be good. Do good. Serve the Lord in all, love all.

101. There is no penance higher than truth-speaking. There is no virtue higher than merey. There is no bliss higher than the bliss of the soul. There is no wealth greater than the spiritual wealth. Hatred is the deadliest foe of an aspirant, whereas love is the pivot of his spiritual life.

102. He who understands the harmonious working of the Inner Government and moves in harmony with the Inner Government and knows the supreme head of the inner Government will attain prosperity, undying fame and glory, eternal bliss and immortality.

103. The foolish man identifies himself with a mass of flesh, fat, skin, bones and filth, while the man of discrimination knows that his Self is distinct from this body.

104. Not through matted locks, not through fiery lectures and erudition, not through exhibition of muracles does one attain perfection of Knowledge of the Self. He in whom the two currents of Ragadwesh, egoism, lust and anger are destroyed in toto is ever happy and he is Brahman or liberated Sage or Jivanmukta.

105. Happiness does not come from wealth. The Western nations are quite restless despite their enormous wealth. From this we can infer that spiritual life alone can give real, everlasting peace and happiness.

Recognise the Value of Your Self

106. Tat Twam Asi. "Thou art That". Pain and suffering, worries and anxieties, diseases and death cannot touch thee. O Ram! these are the passing phantoms which affect only the ignorant. Negate the ego. Assert your Satchidananda Swaroop or Bliss. Thou art the embodiment of bliss. Assert this. Realise it.

107. Everybody is an expression of your own Self. The whole universe is an indivisible whole. No one can separate himself from the rest. All is threaded into one Supreme, the Lord, as the row of pearls in a string. The Lord is the one-thread soul.

108. You are the real master or Governor of the whole world. You are bound to none. Feel the majesty of your Self. Keep yourself peaceful and happy under all circumstances and environments of life. Soar high into a life of beatitude where fear exists not and courage, peace and bliss ever abide.

6. There is but One Being, Brahman or the Infinite. The One appears as a plurality to the uncultured one. The changeless appears becoming and changelble to the ignorant. All is one in essence and nothing independent of Brahman exists. This is the truth. This is the truth.

7. God, Perfection, Peace, Immortality, Bliss are one. The goal of life is to attain Perfection, Immortality or God.

8. The nearer one approaches the Truth, the happier. one becomes. For the essential nature of Truth is positive, Absolute Bliss.

9. Remember God at all times. If you cannot do this. remember death at all times. Either of the two will lead you to emancipation and freedom.

The Purpose Of Human Birth

10. The best of ways is the divine path; the best of virtues is contentment; the best of friends is the Immortal Friend in your own heart.

11. The essence of religion lies in the immediate experiences of the divine. The blissful experience is obtained by regular Sadhana.

12. Thou art Divine. Live up to it. Feel and realise thy divine nature. Conquest of mind will enable you to go to the source of all power, knowledge, peace and bliss. Thy essential nature is Existence-Knowledge-Bliss. Develop the consciousness and realisation of the real 'I within you.

16. Enrich your blood through Japa, Kirtan, meditation, Sattwa, Pranayama, Asans, tomatoes, grapes, spinach, pure air and sunlight.

Ram-Nam-The Supreme Sustainer

17. The Lord's Name is the solution for all the trials of life. Kindly do intense Japa and Kirtan.

18. Japa fills the mind with Bliss. It attunes the soul to God. It brings about perfect communion with God.

19. Lord's Name is a shield for you. It is indeed a strong armour for you. You can never miss the goal if you recite His Name always. Maya can never approach you and tempt you.

20. Be regular in your prayer and Japa. Success will be yours in all your undertakings.

21. When you are in great distress, call for God's help from the very core of your heart. Be sincere. Pray fervently. You will get His help. You will get consolation, peace and inner spiritual strength,

22. Feel "Even this will pass away". Rely on the Lord. Pray fervently. Throw all your burdens on Him and be at ease. He will bear them.

Meditation And Mind-Conquest

23. Transform human nature into divine nature through Satsang, study, prayer, Japa. Kirtan, enquiry and ceaseless meditation.

24. Meditation releases a great amount of spiritual power. By constant meditation on the Self, one attains liberation.

25. Inner spiritual strength, perfect peace, knowledge and bliss are the fruits of meditation.

26. Wherever the mind goes, see the One Lord there. Then the mind will easily come under your control. Constant Japa and prayer will calm the mind and fill it with peace and bliss.

27. By prayer and meditation, kindness, celibacy and non-injury the mind is purified.

28. In the diu and noise of the world, in the midst of sensual pleasures, the mind is led astray. But, if you have firm faith in God, if you offer prayer, if you do Japa. Kirtan and meditation, you are lifted up. No worldly charms can attract or tempt you. You will rest peacefully in God.

29. The world is ruled by ideas. Thought is the beginning of practice. Thought begets actions. Therefore, entertain pure thoughts. Your actions will be noble and sublime.

30. He who has a blameless character and good behaviour can realise the Truth quickly.

31. Man is worse than an animal when he is under the sway of passion and anger.

32. Bear no ill-will towards any one. Even if some one behaves rudely towards you, be kind to him. Serve him with divine bhav. Then alone will you have selfpurification and then alone will you enjoy peace.

33. Anger is the child of ignorance, brother of jealousy, and the father of harshness.

34. Return unkindness with kindness, injury with service and love.

35. Each temptation, each trial is a test by God to find out your strength of will, power of endurance, the degree of dispassion. Stand adamant. Be bold. Be cheerful. Be courageous.

36. There is no misery greater than poverty. Exert and earn.

37. It is heart alone that makes one rich. Be contented. Contentment is the greatest wealth. Realise the Supreme, Inexhaustible Wealth of Atma and be happy for ever.

38. Religious instruction should be gradual, according to the varying receptivity of the aspirant.

39. Preach to others what you yourself practise. Then alone will it produce a strong impression on others. It is casier to preach twenty than to be one of the twenty in following the preaching.
